MEETING MINUTES — SEPT. 24, 2017

The Sept. 24th meeting of the Cuyahoga Valley S-Gaugers was held at the home of Mike and Linda Graham and called to order by President Lee McCarty at 4:09 p.m. with 21 members present.

Greg Melzer read the treasurers report. It is still in good shape with no outstanding debts.

OLD BUSINESS:

None to report.

NEW BUSINESS:

Lee started the meeting by stating that the tinplate and high rail layouts are ready to go to the October NMRA Train Show at the Berea Fairgrounds. Tom Scott will also have his Winter Wonderland layout there. Set up in Berea will take place on Friday at 4:00pm. Lee made it known that extra tables are not available.

The tinplate layout underwent general maintenance over the summer that included replacing the sawmill with the talking station. The Hi-Rail layout got a complete makeover with extensive work performed as outlined below:

- The layout shed about 180 pounds making it easier for people to lift. Some wood had to be replaced.
- The wiring was checked and neatly bundled with excess wire removed. Two areas were found to not have any wires to the track and were corrected. Two Jones plugs had to be replaced as well.
- Uneven track elevations from panel to panel were corrected.
- The track was inspected with a lot of loose rails found.
- Serious changes were made to the scenery giving the layout a whole fresh new look.
- Additional items:
 - ◇ Fender washers added to the ends of the legs to minimize damage.
 - ◇ An easy to transport box for the legs.
 - ◇ J-bolts replaced the C-clamps for the cross-bracing.

- ◇ The number of cross-braces was reduced to 8.
- ◇ C'sk screws replaced the hex head screws in the trailer. The hex head screws were catch points that were causing damage to anything that was pulled or pushed across them.
- ◇ Guide rails added to the trailer shelves to help keep the panels confined within specific areas thus making more efficient use of space.

Much of the work on the high rail layout was done at the home of Jim and Maria Futules where anyone who came to help was served a lunch. Reimbursement for the food provided was voted on and unanimously passed by the members attending.

The high rail layout control panel is still an issue. It is still heavy and difficult to understand how to use it. While it would be convenient to go all DC power, it is not practical in light of the fact that there are a lot of locomotives that require AC power in order to operate correctly. It must accommodate all including any that have DCC or Command Control.

The club's scale locomotives and rolling stock will be sold.

Jim Best from California was placed in a nursing home. Nine days later he passed away. May his memory be eternal.


